Written Health Guarantee

1. The purchaser should have the puppy examined by a licensed veterinarian within three (3) business days of the arrival, or pick up date.
2. The puppy is guaranteed until Two (2) years of age against fatal and life altering congenital and genetic disease which adversely affects the health and normal life of the animal.
3. I, Catherine Betts, must be notified of the problem within two (2) business days of the licensed veterinarian's determination. I will provide a replacement puppy of equivalent value out of the next available litter. The original puppy must be returned to me. Purchaser is responsible for the transportation cost of the original puppy and the replacement puppy.
4. I will not be responsible for veterinarian fees or cost. Purchaser is aware that owning a puppy means trips to the veterinarian and understands that he/she will be responsible for all payments.
5. There is no guarantee or warranty that covers any complications arising from breeding the dog if the owner chooses to breed the dog.
6. Purchaser is required to keep the puppy current on all veterinarian care including shots and de-worming. I recommend keeping the new puppy separate from other dogs in the family until the veterinarian has given it a clean bill of health.
7. Ear cropping, if desired, is done at the purchaser's expense after the puppy leaves the breeder. Purchaser takes all responsibility for health complications resulting from cropping.
